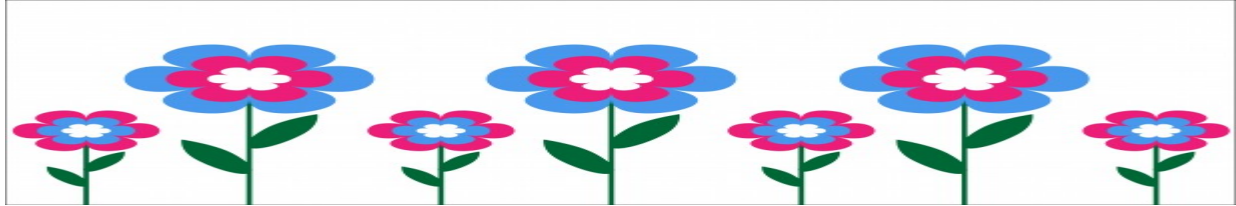


Jan and Patti's Hot Weather Update

Just a few friendly reminders below:



Keep **DOORS** to buildings closed, some residents have been propping doors and leaving doors open. We have a very active coyote population here and we do not want them at our door or when opening your door coming out with your pet.



We all enjoy our beautiful trees here at LaSolana. Unfortunately, there are serious problems with the roughly fifty large Afgan Pine trees planted near our buildings. I believe these were planted about when LaSolana was built, and they are much too large to be so near our buildings.

We have had two incidents in the past two years in which the roots of these trees have broken a large water pipe coming into a building. When this happens we need to have the pipe repaired at considerable expense - and the water needs to be turned off to the entire building affected for several hours or longer while the repair is in progress. Many of the trees are over our water pipes, and so the risk of continued pipe leaks only increases as the tree roots grow.

Another problem with our Afgan Pines is pine borer beetles. All of our pine trees are infested with beetles, some more seriously than others. These beetles are slowly killing the trees, and they will only look more sickly as the infestation progresses. *By Larry Truett*

The LaSolana Board may consider beginning to strategically remove these pines as guided by the arbor experts at Carescape. When we remove these trees we will when possible plant new trees of suitable species in a suitable location. The yellow ribbons on the trees are to identify where the water lines are.

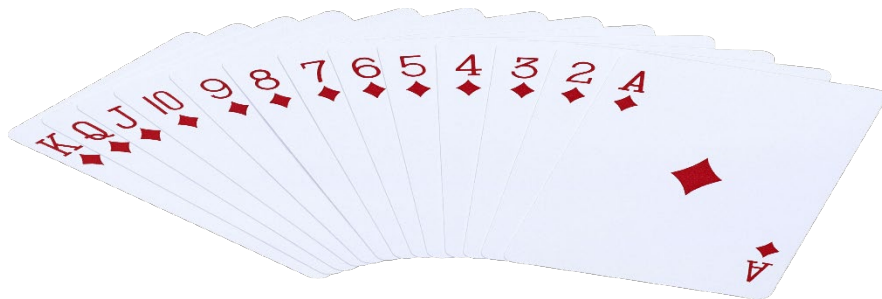

PLEASE DO NOT PUT GARBAGE in the recycle bin. Several incidents have occurred over the last couple of weeks of garbage being placed in the recycle bin and not the garbage compactor. Please read the sign posted on the door if the recycle bin has been moved outside of the locked area due to the compactor being emptied. It's critical that garbage does not go into the recycle as 1, other items in the container are not longer recyclable 2, the container has quite an odor from the garbage.

ALL CONTAINERS MUST BE WASHED OUT NO DIRTY FOOD CONTAINERS, PIZZA BOXES, ETC!!!!!! CLEAN (washed out thoroughly) CANS, CARDBOARD, PLASTIC, etc.!!!

DO NOT empty any shred in a bag or loose into container this needs to go into the garbage and no tied plastic bags. The shred blows out causing quite a mess (windy days) and the tied bags the recycle plant will not open as to not sure what's in the bag. This defeats the purpose of recycling! Please do your part to keep our environment clean!
